● According to a Mayan legend, the Gods told people: "You dance, we'll watch". The flying men, the "Voladores de Papantla" climb up a thirty-metre pole, tie a rope around their feet and launch themselves in to the void. The "Caporal" dances at the very top of the pole while singing traditional ceremonial music. Each performer flies around the pole thirteen times; together they make fifty-two circles. In the Mayan calendar, the year has fifty-two weeks, and fifty-two years make a solar circle. Where?: Moll dels Miradors, every day at 12 pm, 2:30 pm, 5 pm and 7:30 pm. Until September 26th. CIRCUS

► **Grottesco,** by Spanish company Monty & Cia. The magic of the circus in ten stories reflecting tenderness, poetry, diversity, hypocrisy, greed and fear from the ironical point of view of a clown. Site: Marina stage (Port Area). Until July 18th.

KABARET

► **Hildes Kappes.** In her current programme, Unlabelled, Hilde Kappes sings, recites, sobs, laughs and yells about the terrifying joyful side of life. Site: Kabaret. Until July 18th.

► **Leslie Bee.** Currently living in Los Angeles, California, Leslie Bee is known as the black Marilyn Monroe, especially thanks to her great power of communication and her natural ta-

lent for connecting with the public. Site - Peace Port (Port Area). Until July 18th.

MUSIC

► **Ceux qui marchent debout.** Six musicians who reinvented the concept of the traditional brass band and come up with an exciting new formula for the 1990. Their music is mix of funk, ska and soul fused with pounding African and Latino rhythms. Site - Haima Stage (The Plaza). Until June 18th.

PERMANENT PERFORMANCES

► **Move the World (Omkarakala),** by Hansel Cereza and Alfons Flores. Moving the World is a construction of a 30 metres sphere which emerges from the port's waters every evening at the sunset and shows how dialogue among people and cultures is the only antidote to chaos, injustice and violence.

► **Fantòtems.** Marionetas gigantes en el puerto. The Fantòtems are six giant puppets, some 10 metres high, in a performance designed by Joan Baixas as a great game of questions that are difficult to answer about life, the planet and people. The questions are asked by children from around the world through an interactive web-game. Until September 26th. Site - Pan-gaea Island/Rompeolas (Auditorium Park).

► **Day Parade (Pasacalle de Día) - Higroma.** A daytime parade of giant invertebrates that calls for the spectators participation-through small actions and improvisations- with the aim of reflecting on the environment. Site Itinerant.

► **Night Parade (Passacalle de noche) - Summer Night's Dream,** by Sèmolà Teatre. It represents the conflicts of daily life by displaying high-impact scenographic installations throughout the port area. Site - Itinerant.

► **The Giant of the Seven Seas.** A show by La Machine and Escarlata Circus. The Giant of the 7 Seas emerges every day from the waters of the Large Auditorium to make us reflect upon the degradation of the sea. It is an unusual construction measuring 12 metres in height and made of fine materials -wood, leather, brass, etc. Site - Large Auditorium. Two to four performances daily.

► **The Memory Tree.** The Tree of Memory, a living manifesto of sustainability and environ-

mentalism, is a project by Els Comediants, a company that pioneered in making street theatre great. Site-Auditorium Park Area. Two to four times daily.

STREET PERFORMANCES

► **El Bosco. Viaje al infierno.** By Discipulos de Morales company. It takes up El Bosco's Garden of Earthly Delights in a three dimensional interpretation based on street theatre. Site Haima. Until July 18th.

► **El Teatro de Automatas.** Gonzalo Cañas has been collecting and restoring mechanical theatre objects since 1992, and currently owns Spains last remaining theatre of automata. As we walk through the theatre, we come across delightful moving tableaux of daily life and miniature performances. Site: Talismans Plaza (Esplanade Area). Until July 18th.

► **Le Manège d'Andréa.** Built under the supervision of François Delarozière, the Eureka carousel guarantees anyone who chooses to climb aboard an extraordinary journey. Up to 34 children can ride on it. A dizzy circular dance that will thrill children and fascinate adults. Dates: From June 15th to September 26th. Site- Convention Center Boulevard.

► **Annibal.** Opositos enormous mechanical elephants parade to the beat of a group of Indian musicians and dancers. A joyful, festive parade, open to audience participation, fusing the modernity and design of the elephants with traditional Indian costumes and music. Until September 29th. Check for schedule.

► **Le Zaka.** Exhibition of exotic funeral masks, and traditional dance on the music of the group Makava. Ronda Port (Port Area). Until July 22nd.
